Preparing Our Hearts for 2026 by Apostle Collins

Hello, beloved, as we come to the close of another year and stand on the threshold of 2026, my heart is drawn to a simple but powerful truth: God is faithful from generation to generation. He is not caught off guard by the times we live in, the challenges we face, or the questions we carry into a new year. He remains the same faithful God He has always been.

In biblical numerology, the number 26 is often connected with God's covenant, His divine name, His faithfulness, and the power of his salvation. While that may sound technical, it points to something deeply meaningful as we prepare our hearts for the year ahead.

In Hebrew, each letter has a numerical value. God's covenant name, YHWH (Yahweh or Jehovah), totals 26.

Yod = 10

Heh = 5

Vav = 6

Heh = 5

$10 + 5 + 6 + 5 = 26$

This is the name God revealed to Moses at the burning bush, "I AM WHO I AM" (Exodus 3:14). It speaks of His eternal, self-existent nature and reminds us that God does not change with circumstances or seasons.

As we step into 2026, we are stepping into a year that symbolically reflects His name, a gentle reminder that the great "I AM" goes before us.

Throughout the Bible, the number 26 also highlights God's faithfulness across generations. From Adam to Moses, from David to Jesus, and ultimately to Christ Himself, Scripture shows us again and again that God keeps His promises. Even when fulfillment takes generations, He is always at work. He is patiently weaving His purposes through ordinary lives, broken stories, and changing times.

As a church family, we can move into this new year with confidence and hope, trusting that the same faithful God who guided generations before us will continue to lead us today and into the future.
