Comic Title: *Enter The Unreal*

Core Logline

Far beneath the storm-choked surface of the gas giant **Kiliope X**, the last descendants of a forgotten human species fight a civil war older than memory. Their people, now known as the **Kilope**, have lost the truth of where they came from. Their history has been buried, rewritten, and weaponized by those in power.

But from the shadows rises **Famian Keathley**, also known as **Fame** — the original vampire of Kiliope, the source of a growing bloodline, and the most infamous figure in the known world. His followers are known as **The Syndicate**, a vampiric order spreading across the underground empire.

The remaining free people rally under the broken banner of the **United Realms of Deja**, named for the haunting belief that this has all happened before.

And this time, they may not survive it.

The Setting

Kiliope X

Kiliope X is a massive gas planet with an impossible secret: a vast under-surface empire built beneath layers of storm, pressure, and toxic sky. The Kilope people do not live on the surface. They live below it — in metallic cities, buried realms, ancient vaults, and war-scarred tunnels lit by artificial suns.

The surface is considered death. The deep is considered home.

Their civilization is both advanced and ancient. They have futuristic cities, cybernetic infrastructure, gene-altered bloodlines, and glowing blade technology — but they have also regressed in warfare. Guns are rare, unreliable, or forbidden due to the planet's unstable electromagnetic atmosphere and the fallout of past calamities.

So war has returned to the old ways.

Blades. Axes. Daggers. Spears. Armor. Blood. Honor.

Only the strongest warriors carry **Cosmic Weapons** — sacred melee weapons said to have been forged by God before the first migration into the stars.

The Kilope People

The **Kilope** are humanoid descendants of an ancient species that once came from an unknown world. Most citizens believe their origins are lost forever.

The hidden truth: they came from Earth.

But Earth is no longer remembered by name. It exists only as fragments, myths, forbidden symbols, and corrupted stories buried in old archives. The ruling powers of Deja have hidden this truth for generations, believing that knowledge of Earth could collapse what remains of civilization.

The Kilope are brilliant, emotional, ambitious, loyal, violent, creative, and cursed by the same burdens that once haunted humanity.

They escaped Earth to survive.

But they brought humanity's darkness with them.

The Main Conflict

For 105 years, Kilo X has been consumed by civil war.

At first, it was political.

Then it became spiritual.

Then it became something worse.

A new species has risen from within the Kilope people: a vampiric bloodline created by **Famian Keathley**, the first of his kind. His followers call him **The Source**. His enemies call him **Infamian**, though only when they are far outside his reach.

Famian does not simply want to rule.

He wants to rewrite what the Kilope people are.

He believes humanity was always weak because it feared its own hunger, ambition, and darkness. His vision is to evolve the Kilope into something stronger, colder, immortal, and loyal only to him.

The United Realms of Deja believe he is not evolution.

He is extinction wearing a crown.

Major Factions

The United Realms of Deja

The last organized government of the free Kilope people. Deja is built from surviving realms, warrior houses, scientists, old military orders, and underground city-states that still resist Famian's growing empire.

They call themselves “Deja” because their oldest prophets believed history was repeating itself.

They have been here before.

War. Collapse. Migration. Rebirth. Corruption.

But this time, there may be no second escape.

Deja is not perfectly good. Its leaders hide secrets, censor history, and manipulate the population in the name of survival. They fear that the full truth of Earth, Famian, and the Keathley bloodline could break the people's spirit.

Their motto:

“Remember nothing. Defend everything.”

The Syndicate

A vampiric order founded by Famian Keathley. The Syndicate began as a hidden movement among elites, soldiers, outcasts, and war survivors who believed Deja had failed them.

Now it is a growing empire.

The Syndicate promises power, immortality, loyalty, and freedom from fear. To the desperate, they are saviors. To the free realms, they are monsters. To Famian, they are the next step in Kilope evolution.

The Syndicate does not only conquer cities.

It recruits.

It seduces.

It converts.

Its members are bound by blood, oath, and psychic loyalty to The Source.

Their motto:

“Enter the dark. Become unreal.”

The Unreal

This is where your UGS community connection becomes powerful.

The Unreal should be the name of the resistance movement that rises between Deja and The Syndicate. They are not fully loyal to the government, and they are not corrupted by Famian.

They are warriors, gamers, outcasts, leaders, rebels, builders, and legends from across Kiliope X who refuse to let either side define the future.

The Unreal becomes the in-universe mirror of **Unreal Gaming Syndicate**.

UGS members can be marketed as real-world recruits of The Unreal — people entering the lore, earning ranks, unlocking chronicles, competing for Crowns, and becoming part of the living story.

Their motto:

“Enter The Unreal.”

Famian “Fame” Keathley

Famian Keathley was born into one of the most powerful families in Kiloape history.

Long before the war, the Keathley family was rumored to have funded the ancient space program that carried humanity away from its dying homeworld and deep into the cosmos. Their name was once tied to survival, exploration, wealth, and ambition.

Now the name is nearly erased.

The remaining government shelters Keathley records from the population, claiming the truth is too dangerous.

Famian became a legend before he became a monster. He was a businessman, strategist, public figure, and cultural icon. He understood people better than any general. He knew how to sell hope, fear, loyalty, rebellion, and identity.

Then came the transformation.

Famian became the first vampire of Kiliope X.

No one knows whether he discovered the curse, created it, inherited it, or was chosen by something ancient beneath the planet. What is known is this: every true vampire traces back to him.

He is The Founder.

He is The Source.

He is Fame.

And his infamy is so great that even his enemies made a joke of his name:

Infamian.

But no one says it near the dark.

Weapons and Warfare

The ETU Universe has no common guns. The old ranged weapons of humanity became useless after the calamities of Kiliope X. The planet's charged atmosphere, underground pressure systems, and ancient energy scars made firearms unreliable, explosive, or forbidden.

War returned to the hand.

Common weapons include:

Fluxblades — metal swords with laser-charged edges.

Grav-axes — heavy melee weapons that shift weight during combat.

Pulse daggers — short blades used by assassins and scouts.

Oldsteel weapons — traditional blades passed through warrior families.

Cosmic Weapons — divine melee relics said to have been created by God before the first migration.

Cosmic Weapons are rare. They choose their wielders. A weak warrior cannot control one. A corrupt warrior may be consumed by one.

These weapons are not just tools.

They are judgments.

The Crowns

The **Crowns** are legendary titles tied to combat, honor, and dominance.

In the real UGS community, Crowns can be competitive titles earned by members in games.

In ETU lore, Crowns are ancient combat honors from Kiliope X. A warrior who holds a Crown is recognized as the strongest living champion of a specific discipline, weapon, realm, or battlefield.

A Crown must be defended.

A Crown can be challenged.

A Crown can be lost.

This lets the comic universe and the gaming community work together naturally. When UGS members win tournaments, 1v1 challenges, or major events, they can become canon Crown Holders in the ETU Universe.

Example:

The Rocket Crown

The Halo Crown

The Fortnite Crown

The Shadow Crown

The Dragon Crown

The Unreal Crown

Every Crown has lore.

Every holder becomes part of the myth.

Main Themes

Identity

The Kilope do not know they came from Earth. The entire species is living with amnesia. ETU is about discovering who you are after generations of lies.

Legacy

Famian's family helped save humanity, but Famian may become the reason it finally dies.

Community

The Unreal is not one hero. It is a movement. This fits UGS perfectly because the story can grow around members, squads, divisions, and events.

Light and Dark

The war is not simply good versus evil. Deja hides truth. The Syndicate offers belonging. Famian is monstrous, but charismatic. The Unreal must choose a third path.

Repetition

The name Deja comes from déjà vu — the feeling that this has happened before. The people escaped one dying world only to rebuild the same conflicts on another.

Suggested First Comic Arc

Arc One: Blood Beneath the Storm

Issue #1: Enter The Unreal

The story opens beneath the gas storms of Kiliope X, in the underground city of Deja Prime. The city is under curfew. Syndicate raids are increasing. Citizens are disappearing. Government broadcasts deny that Famian has returned.

A young warrior, archivist, or recruit discovers a hidden document bearing the forbidden name:

Keathley.

The file reveals that Famian's family may have helped lead the original migration from a forgotten planet called Earth. Before the recruit can share the truth, the archive is attacked by vampire soldiers of The Syndicate.

During the attack, an ancient Cosmic Weapon awakens.

Not for a king.

Not for a general.

For someone ordinary.

The issue ends with the recruit being pulled into the hidden resistance known as The Unreal.

Final line:

"You wanted the truth. Now enter it."

Issue #2: The Source

The reader learns the legend of Famian Keathley and how he became the first vampire of Kiliope X.

Issue #3: United Realms of Deja

The heroes discover that Deja's government has been hiding more than just history.

Issue #4: Crown Trial

The Unreal recruits must battle for the right to carry a Crown, introducing the community-based Crown system.

Issue #5: Infamian

Famian appears directly for the first time and proves why even his enemies fear his name.

Issue #6: The Earth Lie

The arc ends with the reveal that the Kiloep people are not aliens.

They are humanity's descendants.

And Earth may not be as dead as everyone believes.

How ETU Connects to Unreal Gaming Syndicate

ETU should operate as a living lore layer for UGS.

UGS members are not just readers. They are recruits of The Unreal.

Community events can unlock canon entries. Tournament winners can become Crown Holders. Squad leaders can be written into field reports. Discord roles can have lore equivalents. Website badges can become relics, titles, or military records inside the ETU Universe.

Possible integrations:

UGS Divisions become warrior houses or military branches inside The Unreal.

Dragonborn becomes a frontline order tied to fire, honor, and ancient beasts.

Shadowforge becomes a covert order of smiths, spies, and assassins.

Double Helix becomes a science, genetics, and medical division studying the vampire curse.

Crowns become canon combat titles.

Leadership meetings become "War Councils."

Community game nights become "Realm Operations."

Member awards become in-universe medals, relics, or archive entries.

Top members can appear in side stories, wanted posters, mission logs, or background cameos.

The comic sells the fantasy.

The community lives inside it.

Enter The Unreal is not just a comic.

It is the official mythos of Unreal Gaming Syndicate.

A cyberpunk fantasy war story where gaming culture, clan identity, competition, leadership, and community become part of a living universe.
