### Introduction

Vale of Leithen Football Club aims to create and maintain an environment where spectators can enjoy the game of football safe in the knowledge that they are free from harassment, abuse, unacceptable conduct and disorderly conduct.

This policy applies to football matches and events within Victoria Park, Innerleithen, and at away ground fixtures.

### Definition

Unacceptable conduct is conduct which is violent or disorderly.

- Actual, attempted or threatened physical violence against a person or persons.
- Intentional damage to property.
- Activity which stirs up, sustains, or is likely or designed to stir up or sustain hatred or ill will against individuals or groups because of gender, age, colour, race, nationality, ethnic or national origin, religion, belief, sexual orientation, transgender identity or disability.

### Club Response

The club will make this policy public in match programmes and on the official website and will keep the policy under review.

Additions or amendments may be made where deemed appropriate by the club or on the advice of governing bodies, police or other relevant bodies.
