Entry Condition

Entry to the ground, whether on payment or otherwise, is deemed to constitute an unqualified acceptance of and undertaking to comply with the Ground Regulations and relevant football rules.

Purpose

The Ground Regulations set the behaviour and safety standards expected of all persons entering Victoria Park, Innerleithen.

They support a safe, lawful and enjoyable matchday environment and help the club and relevant authorities respond appropriately where rules are breached.

Key Principles

- Supporters and visitors must comply with lawful instructions from club officials, stewards, police officers and emergency services personnel.
- Any behaviour that endangers safety, causes disorder, threatens others or damages property is prohibited.
- Items, substances or conduct that could put people at risk or disrupt the event may be prohibited or removed.
- The club may share details, images and the results of arrests, detentions or prosecutions connected with a match in accordance with agreed protocols with Police Scotland.
- Football Banning Orders may be imposed on individuals who breach or fail to comply with the Ground Regulations.
