- Authority is available immediately and continues if incapacity occurs.
- Does not cover health or personal care and cannot be used for real-estate title transactions.

LAWYER-PREPARED OPTION

A tailored Will, prepared with legal advice

\$780 per person + tax

The lawyer-prepared option is recommended where a client wants individualized advice or has a blended family, business interests, property outside British Columbia, a vulnerable beneficiary, an intended exclusion, trust needs or a risk of conflict.
