Croatian Wilderness

TROGIR – PUČIŠĆA – KORČULA – LASTOVO – RAVNIK (GREEN CAVE) – VIS/ KOMIŽA – BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE) – STARI GRAD – BOL – TROGIR

Explore the Croatian wilderness while island hopping and following the route that goes “off the beaten track”. Perfect for any true traveller, adventure seeker and nature lover. Begin and end your journey in the UNESCO-listed town of Trogir before venturing into Croatia’s most remote and untouched islands – Lastovo Nature Park, hidden caves, and secluded bays rarely reached by larger vessels.





DAY 1 TROGIR– PUČIŠĆA (L)

Check-in from 11:00h in Trogir harbour. Departure at 13:00h followed by lunch onboard and a swimming stop. Cruise to Pučišća on the northern side of Brač, a typical Mediterranean town set at the bottom of a deep bay. It is famous for the white Brač stone used in the construction of notable buildings such as the White House in Washington and Liverpool Cathedral. Optional visit to a traditional stone masonry workshop, one of the few still operating in Europe. Overnight in the port of Pučišća.

DAY 2 PUČIŠĆA – KORČULA (B, L)

Early morning departure toward Korčula, the birthplace of Marco Polo. Swim stop en route to enjoy a morning swim in the crystal blue sea. Lunch will be served either on the tip of the Pelješac peninsula (near Lovište) or in the quiet bay of Kneža on the Korčula island. Arrive in the afternoon, followed by a guided sightseeing tour of the exceptional Korčula town (included on Premium and Premium Superior). According to legend, Korčula was founded by the Trojan hero Antenor in the 12th century B.C. Many legends and tales can be found here, as well as impressive monuments. In the evening, we recommend visiting one of the numerous local taverns or enjoying stunning views from the numerous cafes and bars. Overnight in one of the ports of Korčula, depending on availability (the main port in the town centre/ port of Dominče / ferry port (3 km away)).

DAY 3 KORČULA – LASTOVO (B, L, CD)

The cruise continues towards Lastovo, the farthest inhabited island in Dalmatia (entrance fee for Lastovo Nature Park included). Once docked, the local bus or taxi takes you to Lastovo village for a visit to the local winery and a tasting of indigenous wine sorts (optional). The island is surrounded by many smaller islets, with secluded bays and coves perfect for snorkelling. The town is also known for its many small churches and unusually shaped chimneys, unique to Lastovo. Overnight in Jurjeva Luka, Ubli, or on anchor, with the Captain's Dinner on board (included on Premium and Premium Superior).

DAY 4 LASTOVO – RAVNIK (GREEN CAVE) – VIS/ KOMIŽA (B, L)

Early morning departure toward Vis Island, which, due to its unique geographical position, served as a strategic harbour for the Yugoslav navy and was off-limits to tourists for many years. Because of that isolation, Vis has kept a distinctive charm often described as “the Mediterranean as it once was.” Nearby lies the tiny island of Ravnik, home to the Green Cave (entrance fee to be paid on the spot). The cave gets its name from the striking green light that reflects through an opening in the ceiling, creating a surreal glow in the water. After a short swim stop, continue toward the island. Overnight will be in Vis or Komiža (depending on berth availability). The town of Vis grew near the remains of ancient Issa, the first urban centre in Croatia, founded by the Greeks in the 4th century BC. Visit the Roman Baths and the City Museum, or enjoy a walk along the coast with views of the villae rusticae that still line the shore.

DAY 5 VIS/ KOMIŽA – BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE) – STARI GRAD (B, L)

Early in the morning, cruise toward the little island Biševo, to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon (entrance fee is to be paid on the spot, the possibility of a visit depends on weather conditions). After the Blue Cave, the cruise resumes towards Stari Grad on the island of Hvar. Records confirm that Hvar is the sunniest island in the Adriatic. Afternoon at leisure to explore Stari Grad on your own or join an optional guided tour of Stari Grad (included on Premium Superior). The famous Stari Grad Field (a plain) is the oldest in Croatia and the best-preserved example of the ancient Greek system of agriculture. Both the old town and this plain are part of the world heritage protected by UNESCO. Overnight in one of the ports of Stari Grad, the main port, or ferry port (2 km away), depending on availability.

DAY 6 STARI GRAD – BOL (B, L)

After breakfast, cruise toward the beautiful Brač island and the famous town of Bol, which has one of the most unusual and most photographed beaches in Dalmatia, Zlatni Rat (Golden Horn), which you can visit on foot. The famous beach shifts from side to side, changing shape according to the direction of the wind and waves. Bol is a charming fishermen's town and a famous tourist destination. Take a walk or cycle along the promenade. Hike or rent a scooter to visit Vidova Gora (at 778m, the highest peak on all Adriatic islands) for a spectacular view of Bol and beyond or visit the semi-abandoned village of Murvica. Find a nice tavern or restaurant and taste excellent fresh fish, local wines, and other delicacies of this unique island. Overnight in Bol.

DAY 7 BOL – TROGIR(B, L)

Enjoy the final morning relaxing and swimming in secluded bays around the island of Brač before cruising towards Trogir in the early afternoon. Approaching the UNESCO-listed town by sea reveals its compact medieval skyline rising above the waterfront. Trogir's old town, set on a small island between the mainland and Čiovo, is a harmonious blend of Romanesque, Gothic and Renaissance architecture. Wander through narrow marble streets, lively squares and along the promenade, or join an optional guided walking tour (included on Premium Superior). Overnight in Trogir.

DAY 8 TROGIR (B)

After early breakfast, check-out and farewell to the crew and new friends. Trogir is conveniently located just a short drive from Split Airport.

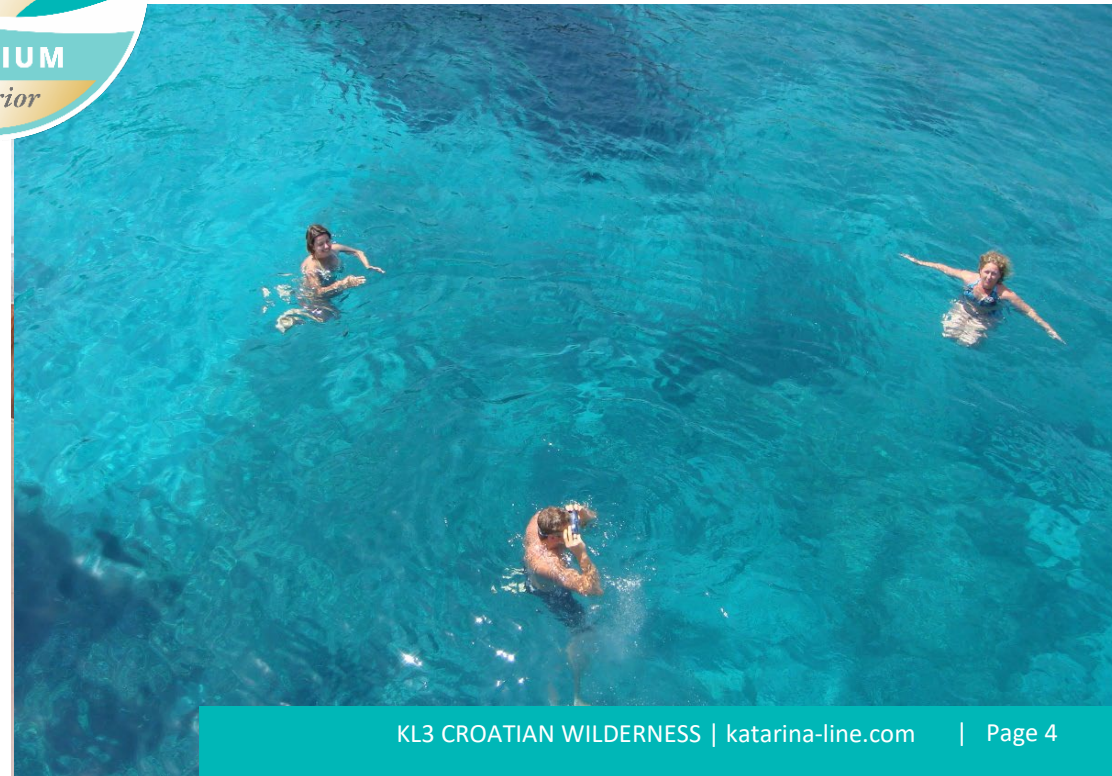

PAYMENT:

A **non-refundable deposit** is to be paid upon reservation. The outstanding balance is to be paid at the latest 45 days before the departure date for individual bookings (up to 4 cabins) and at the latest 12 weeks before the departure date for small group reservations (5 or more cabins).

- **€ 300** per person for classic cruises

- **€ 150** per person per guaranteed land pre or post-cruise tour of 7+ nights or when booking stand-alone land tours
- **€ 50** per person per guaranteed pre or post-cruise land tour of up to 6 nights

SPECIAL NOTES:

- The captain reserves the right to change the route in case of bad weather conditions or to modify the itinerary should unforeseen port conditions arise.
- Due to the limited number of berths in certain ports—especially in Hvar and Vis—there is a possibility that the vessel will instead dock or anchor in alternative ports such as Stari Grad (for Hvar) or Komiža (for Vis).
- All Katarina Line cruise departures are guaranteed; however, Katarina Line reserves the right to cancel a departure if fewer than 20 participants are booked.
- Katarina Line reserves the right to change the vessel if the need arises, including in cases of charter arrangements. Notification will be sent at least 30 days before departure.
- Passengers are obliged to follow the Ship Rules (found in written form on the ship), particularly regarding the bringing of drinks on board. In case of inappropriate behaviour, Katarina Line and/or the Captain reserves the right to request passengers to disembark.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Individual bookings (up to 4 cabins):

- From the day of confirmation up till 45 days before arrival - non-refundable deposit
- 44-30 days - deposit + 25% of the remaining balance
- 29-22 days - deposit + 50% of the remaining balance
- 21 - 0 days - 100% fee

Small group bookings (5 and more cabins):

- From the day of confirmation up till 85 days before departure – advance payment is non-refundable
- 84 – 56 days – deposit +25% of the remaining balance
- 55 – 49 days – deposit +50% of the remaining balance
- 48 – 42 days – deposit +75% of the remaining balance
- 41 – 0 days 100% fee

Name change fee - € 20 per person / Date change fee - € 20 per person - valid only if the change is done up to 45 days before booked departure, otherwise regular cancellation conditions will be applied.

Both can not be combined for a single reservation.
