Bike Cruise Dalmatia South

TROGIR – ROGAČ, MILNA– STARI GRAD, JELSA, HVAR – KORČULA – NP MLJET – TRSTENIK, KUĆIŠTE – SUĆURAJ, PUČIŠĆA – POSTIRA, TROGIR

This guided cycling tour in Dalmatia begins and concludes in Trogir, taking you on an unforgettable journey through Croatia's stunning coastlines, medieval towns, and charming villages. You'll pedal through picturesque bays, discover pristine beaches, and ride amidst lush vineyards and fragrant pine woods. The tour also includes visits to historic islands and the breathtaking Mljet National Park. Croatia, with its stunning islands, rich cultural heritage, Mediterranean vegetation, and mild climate, offers the perfect setting for an immersive cycling adventure. There's no better way to explore this beautiful land than by bike.





DAY 1 TROGIR - ROGAČ - MILNA (L)

Bike Course: Rogač – Maslinica – Rogač | **Length:** 20 km | **Highest point:** 280 m
Difficulty level: 1/5

Check-in from 11:00 in Trogir. Departure at 13:00, followed by lunch on board on the journey to the island of Šolta. Upon arrival in Rogač, cycle through charming landscapes on your way to the coastal town of Maslinica. After taking in the sights, cycle back to Rogač, where the ship awaits you to continue your adventure. Depending on port conditions, an alternative cycling route on Šolta Island may be considered: Stomorska - Gornje Selo - Maslinica - Stomorska. Departure to Milna on Brač Island. Overnight in Milna or Stari Grad, depending on conditions.

DAY 2 MILNA - STARI GRAD - JELSA - HVAR (B, L)

ROUTE 1: Stari Grad -Jelsa - Vrboska - Stari Grad | **Length:** 22 Km | **Total Ascent:** 110m
Highest point: 85 M | **Difficulty Level:** 1/5 | **Surface:** 85% paved road, 15% macadam |
ROUTE 2: Stari Grad - Hvar - **Length:** 23 km | **Total Ascent** 450 m | **Difficulty level** 3/5 |
Surface: 100% paved road

Early morning cruise from Milna to the town of Stari Grad with breakfast on board. From Stari Grad, cycle through Stari Grad Plain (preserved ancient Greek land division) toward two pearls - Jelsa and Vrboska. Enjoy stunning landscapes, lavender fields, and views of neighbouring islands and the mainland. Return to Stari Grad and lunch on board. After lunch, we continue with our bike route and cycle to the historic town of Hvar, known for its architecture, beautiful nature, and mild climate. Free time to explore Hvar. Overnight in Hvar or Vela Luka (depending on port conditions).

DAY 3 HVAR - KORČULA (B, D)

Bike Course: Vela Luka - Korčula | **Length:** 55 km | **Highest point:** 850 m | **Difficulty level:** 3/5

Begin your day in Vela Luka and embark on a scenic bike ride across the island of Korčula. Cycle through lush vineyards, olive groves, and charming villages, making your way to the historic town of Korčula. Explore the medieval architecture, vibrant local culture, and beautiful waterfront of Korčula town. After a fulfilling day of cycling and sightseeing, overnight in one of the ports of Korčula, depending on availability (main port in the town centre/ port of Dominče / ferry port (3 km away).

DAY 4 KORČULA – NP MLJET (B, L, CD)

Bike Course: National Park Mljet | **Length:** 18 km | **Highest point:** 160 m | **Difficulty level:** 1/5

Cruise during breakfast from Korčula to Mljet Island, the lush green island also known as “honey island”. Morning swim stop, followed by lunch on board. Mljet National Park (entrance fee required for all guests) is a stunning area with saltwater lakes, lush vegetation, cliffs, islets, and an indented coastline surrounded by evergreen hills. Cycle around the saltwater lake, inside which there is another island with the Benedictine monastery from the 12th century. Free afternoon for exploring the park on your own.

Captain's Dinner on Board (included in the Premium Superior and Premium category). Overnight in Pomena or Polača.

DAY 5 NP MLJET – TRSTENIK – KUČIŠTE (B, D)

Bike Course: Trstenik - Orebić - Kučište | **Length:** 32 km | **Highest point:** 500 m | **Difficulty level:** 3/5

Today's ride could be called the panoramic wine route. After breakfast, start riding from Trstenik through the picturesque vineyards of the south side of Pelješac. Cross the tunnel Dingač and continue to the renowned vineyard area, famous for the best varieties of Croatian wine. Descend towards Orebić, the city of seafarers and captains, enjoying unique viewpoints of the Korčula archipelago along the way. Conclude your day with a few kilometres of ascending and then descending to reach your destination. Overnight in Kučište.

DAY 6 KUČIŠTE - SUĆURAJ - PUČIŠĆA (B, L)

Bike Course: Sućuraj – Pokrivenik | **Length:** 32 km | **Highest point:** 470 m | **Difficulty level:** 2/5

Breakfast and morning cruise towards the longest Croatian island, Hvar, with a view of the Biokovo mountain. Disembark on the eastern tip of Hvar Island where the cycling tour begins. A ride through picturesque landscapes and coastal views. Ascend to the highest point of the route before descending to the tranquil bay of Pokrivenik where the ship will be waiting. Enjoy lunch on board as you cruise towards Brač Island. Overnight in Pučišća, a postcard-perfect village where stone craftsmanship meets serene Adriatic beauty.

DAY 7 PUČIŠĆA – POSTIRA – TROGIR (B, L)

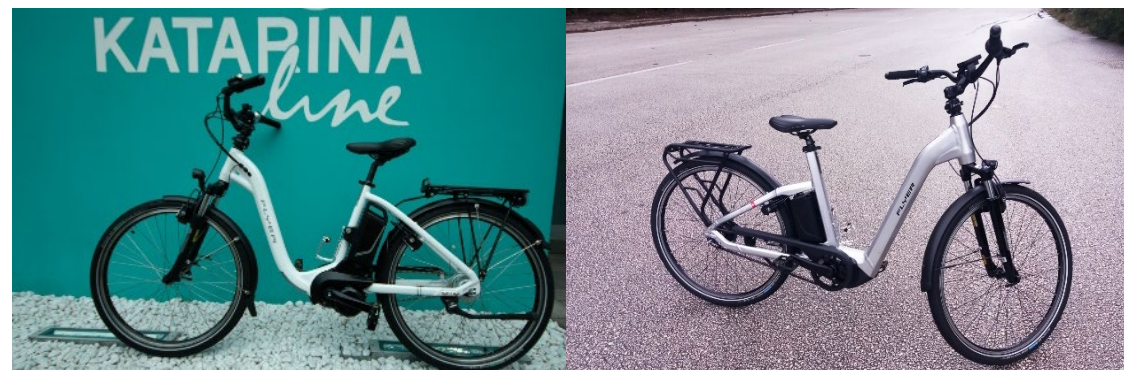
Bike Course: Pučišća – Postira – Supetar | **Length:** 25 km | **Highest point:** 360 m
Difficulty level: 2/5

Embark on a picturesque cycling journey from Pučišća, starting with a scenic ride to Postira. Pedal through charming villages and coastal paths, enjoying the serene beauty of Brač Island. Continue the cycling adventure to Supetar, the island's largest town, known for its beautiful beaches and historic architecture. After exploring Supetar, return for lunch on board and a relaxing journey back to Split, where you can reflect on the day's adventures and enjoy the coastal views along the way. Overnight in Split.

DAY 8 TROGIR (B)

An early breakfast, followed by check-out and farewell to the crew.

CANCELLATION FEE FOR BICYCLES

Cancellation without charges for bicycles is possible up to 5 days before departure. For cancellations made 4 days or less before departure, a 100% cancellation fee applies.

BICYCLE TYPES & RECOMMENDATIONS

Katarina Line bike cruises offer both traditional bicycles and electric bicycles (e-bikes). However, due to the demanding terrain and frequent ascents along the routes, the majority of participants opt for e-bikes. To maintain the group's pace and ensure an enjoyable experience, we *strongly recommend* selecting an e-bike. Guests bringing their own e-bikes must also bring:

- A battery charger
- The battery key, to allow battery removal from the frame

If the battery cannot be removed, the bicycle becomes significantly heavier, which places unnecessary strain on the guides and crew.

Personal e-bikes equipped with non-removable integrated batteries are not allowed.

SWIMMING BREAKS & CYCLING ROUTES

When weather permits and depending on the itinerary, swimming stops are planned—either in secluded bays or after the cycling portion of the day, before continuing to the next island.

The length and difficulty of daily cycling routes may vary due to local conditions, detours, or shortcuts. Both sailing and cycling plans are flexible and may be adjusted according to the weather and the group's ability. Departures typically take place in the morning, usually after breakfast.

BICYCLES & PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITY

Bicycles can be rented upon request. Participants are responsible for their own safety and are expected to follow the guide's instructions at all times. The guide may alter the itinerary depending on the weather or group capabilities.

Guests bringing their own bicycles are required to bring the following:

- A bike lock, especially important when the bicycle is stored near the vessel or left unattended during swim stops
- A repair kit
- Tools for assembly/disassembly if needed
- A helmet, which is strongly recommended for all cycling activities

Katarina Line is not liable for any damage to personal bicycles during the tour or transfers between land and vessel. Guests are responsible for maintaining, assembling, disassembling, and packing/unpacking their bicycles. Guests who rent bicycles accept full responsibility for their condition and agree to return them in the same state. Any damage will be charged according to Katarina Line's spare parts price list, available from the guide upon request.

FOOD & ADDITIONAL MEALS

The program includes breakfast and either lunch or dinner. During cycling days, we suggest stopping at local restaurants to enjoy authentic regional cuisine. These meals are not included in the cruise price and are paid for directly by the guests.

A Captain's Dinner is included for guests on the Premium and Premium Superior categories, and available for purchase on board for guests in the Traditional Ensuite category. This special evening is hosted by the captain and your tour guide.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT FOR BIKE CRUISES

We recommend packing the following for your bike cruise:

- Biking shoes or sturdy sneakers
- Refillable water bottle
- Backpack
- Sunglasses and cycling gloves
- Sun protection (hat, sunscreen)
- Light rain gear
- Extra clothing layers
- **Helmet** essential for your safety

Wearing a helmet is *strongly advised* for all cycling activities. Whether you are on a casual ride or a longer tour, a helmet provides crucial protection and significantly reduces the risk of serious injury in the event of a fall or accident.

👉 If a participant chooses not to wear a helmet, he/she will be required to sign a Helmet Waiver Declaration acknowledging the risks and releasing Katarina Line from liability.

WHEN RIDING IN A GROUP, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- ✓ Respect the agreed departure time.
- ✓ Check the condition of your bike and the battery charge before departure
- ✓ Request your guide's phone number and have it always with you.
- ✓ Follow your guides and respect their instructions
- ✓ If, for any reason, you do not want to ride in the group, inform your guide. If you decide to ride individually, you must take responsibility for the route, bike repairs, and handling any accidents. Take care of your bike's safety. Respect the agreed meeting place and time. Be sure to leave your phone number with the guide.
- ✓ Obey traffic regulations on public roads,
- ✓ Signal turns with your left or right hand, and raise your hand to indicate your intention to stop. Try to stop gradually, always stopping on the right side of the road.
- ✓ Keep a distance of at least 5 meters from the cyclist in front of you. Ride in a single-file line.
- ✓ When stopping, always pull off the road and do not leave your bike on the roadway.
- ✓ If you lose contact with the group and are unsure of the direction to take, stop and wait. If the group has two guides, wait for the last one; if there is only one guide, inform them by phone or wait for them.
- ✓ Regardless of riding in a group, each person is responsible for safely crossing intersections or roads.
- ✓ In the event of an accident with a group member, do not stop on the road and try to secure the accident scene.
- ✓ In case of a technical failure, pull off the road and contact your guide or wait for another guide.
- ✓ Carry enough water and wear appropriate clothing for sun or rain protection.
- ✓ Cycling is only allowed with closed-toe footwear – wearing flip-flops, sandals, or similar open-toe shoes is not permitted.
- ✓ If you are joining the Katarina Line bike cruise with your bicycle, we kindly remind you to bring a lock for securing your bike. This is especially important when the bikes are placed in front of the vessel or during swim stops from the mainland while on a bike route.
- ✓ Clients bringing their e-bikes should also bring their battery chargers.
- ✓ Clients bringing their e-bikes must also bring the battery key so the battery can be detached from the frame. Otherwise, the bike becomes significantly heavier, placing unnecessary strain on the guides and crew.

- Katarina Line reserves the right to change the vessel if the need arises, including in cases of charter arrangements. Notification will be sent at least 30 days before departure.
- Passengers are obliged to follow the Ship Rules (found in written form on the ship), particularly regarding the bringing of drinks on board. In case of inappropriate behaviour, Katarina Line and/or the Captain reserves the right to request passengers to disembark.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Individual bookings (up to 4 cabins):

- From the day of confirmation up till 45 days before arrival - non-refundable deposit
- 44-30 days - deposit + 25% of the remaining balance
- 29-22 days - deposit + 50% of the remaining balance
- 21 - 0 days - 100% fee

Small group bookings (5 and more cabins):

From the day of confirmation up till 85 days before departure – advance payment is non-refundable
84 – 56 days – deposit +25% of the remaining balance
55 – 49 days – deposit +50% of the remaining balance
48 – 42 days – deposit +75% of the remaining balance
41 – 0 days 100% fee

Name change fee - € 20 per person / Date change fee - € 20 per person - valid only if the change is done up to 45 days before booked departure, otherwise regular cancellation conditions will be applied.

Both can not be combined for a single reservation.
