DUBROVNIK – ŠIPAN OR SLANO – NP MLJET, KORČULA – BIŠEVO, VIS/ KOMIŽA – HVAR – BOL, MAKARSKA – PUČIŠĆA – MARINA BAOTIĆ

From the walls of Dubrovnik to the heart of central Dalmatia, this southern Adriatic cruise connects Croatia's most iconic UNESCO towns with hidden bays, emerald national parks and the irresistible rhythm of island life. Swim in secluded coves, explore medieval towns by night and let the crew take care of everything in between—ending your journey just moments from historic Trogir.





DAY 1 DUBROVNIK – ŠIPAN / SLANO (L)

Departure from Dubrovnik harbour Gruž at 13:00h (late arrivals can join in Slano), lunch is served while navigating along the Dalmatian coast either to one of the Elaphiti islands - Šipan, or to the small village Slano on the mainland. Both are peaceful fishermen's villages where there is often a fabulous sunset. Overnight in the port.

DAY 2 ŠIPAN OR SLANO – NP MLJET – KORČULA (B, L)

After breakfast, cruise towards the island and Mljet National Park (entrance fee to be paid on the spot). Lunch on board. Free time to enjoy the salt lakes in the National Park and enjoy the sun and sea on this tranquil island. The large lake is inside the National park, and in the middle one can visit an old abbey and church, or just use a canoe to roam around the lakes in the National park. Bicycles can also be hired to cycle around the paths surrounding the lakes. Continue to the island of Korčula where we arrive in the late afternoon. Join our guided tour of Korčula (included on Premium Superior). Surrounded by ancient walls and fortified bastions Korčula's old town is very well preserved. Overnight in one of the ports of Korčula, depending on availability (the main port in the town centre/ port of Dominče / ferry port (3

DAY 3 KORČULA – BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE), VIS/ KOMIŽA (B, L)

Early in the morning, cruise toward the little island of Biševo to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. The visit depends on sea conditions; entrance tickets are paid on the spot. After the cave, continue toward the island of Vis, once a strategic harbour for the Yugoslav navy and closed to the public for decades. Thanks to that isolation, Vis kept the rare charm of "the Mediterranean as it once was." Overnight will be in Vis or Komiža (depending on berth availability). Vis sits on the northern side of the island, developed near the remains of ancient Issa, the first urban centre in Croatia. If you feel like exploring, visit the Roman Thermal Baths and the City Museum, or enjoy a walk along the waterfront with views of the villae rusticae scattered along the shore. For travellers who want to see more, renting a car or scooter is an easy way to discover the rest of this surprisingly wild island.

DAY 4 VIS/ KOMIŽA – HVAR (B, L)

The next destination is the tiny island of Šćedro near the Hvar island. Upon arrival, time to relax and refresh in the clean, crystal blue sea. Departure towards Hvar after lunch, followed by an optional guided tour (included on Premium Superior). Hvar is the longest island in the Adriatic. Visit the magnificent Renaissance cathedral with its original tower and the oldest community theatre in Europe which was founded here in 1612. Hvar offers plenty of restaurants, bars cafes and clubs, open long into the night. Overnight in the Hvar harbour.

DAY 5 HVAR - BOL – MAKARSKA (B, L)

Leave Hvar behind and continue cruising towards the island of Bračcruise towards Brač island and the famous town of Bol, a typical fishermen's village but also a popular tourist spot. From here, visit the most famous (and most photographed) beach in Dalmatia, Zlatni Rat – renowned for its ever-changing shape, a shingle bar that moves according to the wind. Enjoy a walk through the pine forest from Bol to the Golden Horn beach or ride the tourist train (with an additional fee). Back on the ship,, cruise towards Makarska, a town with a Mediterranean feel. During a stroll, discover numerous churches and other architectural and cultural sites. Overnight in port.

DAY 6 MAKARSKA – PUČIŠĆA (B, L, CD)

Today's destination is Pučišća, a typical Mediterranean village, situated on the northern side of Brač island at the bottom of a deep bay. But before reaching it, stop for swimming and relax in some secluded bay along the route. After lunch on board, explore Pučišća, home of the world-famous white stone of Brač. There is a possibility of visiting one of the few stone masonry workshops left in Europe. Overnight in the port with the Captain's dinner onboard (included on Premium Superior & Premium category vessels).

DAY 7 PUČIŠĆA – MARINA BAOTIĆ (B, L)

After breakfast, depart from Pučišća and cruise towards your final destination – Marina Baotić, near the UNESCO-listed town of Trogir. En route, enjoy a swim stop in a secluded bay followed by lunch onboard. Arrival is scheduled for the early afternoon. Often described as a living museum, Trogir is just a short transfer away. This beautifully preserved medieval town is set on a small island between the mainland and Čiovo, offering an intimate finale to your Adriatic journey. Join a guided walking tour (included on Premium & Premium Superior) through narrow marble streets lined with Renaissance and Baroque palaces. Visit the Cathedral of St. Lawrence and admire Radovan's Portal, one of the finest examples of Romanesque art in Croatia. Evening at leisure to enjoy the atmosphere of this charming coastal town. Overnight in Marina Baotić.

DAY 8 MARINA BAOTIĆ (B)

Breakfast and time to say goodbye to the crew and your new friends before disembarkation.

- Due to the limited number of berths in certain ports—especially in Hvar and Vis—there is a possibility that the vessel will instead dock or anchor in alternative ports such as Stari Grad (for Hvar) or Komiža (for Vis).
- All Katarina Line cruise departures are guaranteed; however, Katarina Line reserves the right to cancel a departure if fewer than 20 participants are booked.
- Katarina Line reserves the right to change the vessel if the need arises, including in cases of charter arrangements. Notification will be sent at least 30 days before departure.
- Passengers are obliged to follow the Ship Rules (found in written form on the ship), particularly regarding the bringing of drinks on board. In case of inappropriate behaviour, Katarina Line and/or the Captain reserves the right to request passengers to disembark.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Individual bookings (up to 4 cabins):

- From the day of confirmation up till 45 days before arrival - non-refundable deposit
- 44-30 days - deposit + 25% of the remaining balance
- 29-22 days - deposit + 50% of the remaining balance
- 21 - 0 days - 100% fee

Small group bookings (5 and more cabins):

- From the day of confirmation up till 85 days before departure – advance payment is non-refundable
- 84 – 56 days – deposit +25% of the remaining balance
- 55 – 49 days – deposit +50% of the remaining balance
- 48 – 42 days – deposit +75% of the remaining balance
- 41 – 0 days 100% fee

Name change fee - € 20 per person / Date change fee - € 20 per person - valid only if the change is done up to 30 days before booked departure, otherwise regular cancellation conditions will be applied.

Both can not be combined for a single reservation.
