Food is Medicine Foundation, Inc. (“**we**,” “**our**,” or “**us**”) appreciates your interest in the websites and digital platforms that we operate (collectively, the “**Sites**”). Protecting your privacy is important to us.

In connection with providing information, features, products, and services through the Sites, we may request or collect information from you, either as anonymous data or personally identifiable information. As part of our commitment to safeguarding your privacy, this Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect the information we obtain from you through the Sites. This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and forms part of the Sites’ Terms and Conditions.

By accessing or using the Sites, you agree to this Privacy Policy, including the transfer, processing, and storage of your information in the United States, and consent to our collection and use of such information as described herein. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, you should not access or use the Sites.

Scope of This Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect:

- On the Sites;
- In email and other electronic communications between you and the Sites; and
- Through mobile or desktop applications you download from the Sites, which enable non-browser-based interaction between you and the Sites.

This Privacy Policy does **not** apply to information collected:

- Offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by us or any third party not governed by this Privacy Policy; or
- By any third party, including through applications or content that may link to or be accessible from the Sites.

Changes to This Privacy Policy

We reserve the right to modify or update this Privacy Policy at any time by posting the revised version on the Sites. Any changes will become effective immediately upon posting.

Your continued use of the Sites after any updates constitutes your acceptance of those changes. We encourage you to review this Privacy Policy periodically. The “Last Updated” date above reflects the most recent revisions.

Children Under the Age of 13

We do not knowingly collect or solicit personal information from children under the age of 13.

Information We Collect and How We Collect It

We collect various types of information from and about users of the Sites, including:

Personal Information You Provide

To access certain features or services on the Sites, you may be asked to provide information that can identify you, such as:

- Name
- Geographic location
- Mailing address
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Payment information (e.g., credit card details)
- Transaction records
- Other identifying information

This information may be required, for example, to create an account, make a donation, or request information or services. If you choose not to provide required information, certain features or services may not be available to you.

We collect personal information only when you voluntarily provide it, such as when you:

- Complete forms on the Sites
- Respond to surveys
- Subscribe to email communications
- Contact us directly via email

Automatically Collected Non-Personal Information

We may automatically collect information that does not directly identify you as you navigate the Sites, including:

- IP address
- Domain server
- Device type and browser
- Internet connection details
- Date and time of visits
- Browsing behavior and usage patterns
- Traffic data

We use technologies such as cookies, web beacons, and pixel tags to collect this information.

You may configure your browser to refuse or disable cookies; however, doing so may limit functionality or affect your experience on the Sites. The Sites may not respond to “Do Not Track” signals.

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect or that you provide to us for purposes including:

- Presenting the Sites and their content to you;
- Providing information, products, or services you request;
- Fulfilling the purposes for which you provide the information;
- Performing obligations and enforcing rights under agreements, including billing and collections;
- Notifying you of updates or changes to the Sites or our services;
- Improving and enhancing the Sites;
- Enabling location-based features where applicable;
- Supporting interactive features of the Sites;
- Any other purpose disclosed at the time you provide the information; and

- Any other purpose with your consent.

You may request to update, correct, or delete your personal information, or opt out of receiving communications from Food is Medicine Foundation, Inc. by contacting us via email or using the “unsubscribe” link included in our communications. We will use reasonable efforts to honor your request.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated, non-identifiable information about our users without restriction.

We do **not** sell, rent, or trade your personally identifiable information to unaffiliated third parties.

We may disclose personal information:

- To contractors, service providers, and partners who support our operations;
- In connection with a merger, restructuring, sale, or transfer of assets;
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provided the information;
- For any purpose disclosed at the time of collection; or
- With your consent.

We may also disclose personal information:

- To comply with legal obligations, court orders, or regulatory requests;
- To enforce our Terms and Conditions or other agreements; or
- When necessary to protect the rights, property, or safety of Food is Medicine Foundation, Inc., our users, or others.

Security Measures

We implement a range of current technologies and safeguards to protect your information. Data collected through the Sites is stored in secure environments, and we use encryption where appropriate for sensitive data transmissions.

We take reasonable steps to protect your information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access, alteration, or disclosure. Where applicable, we require third parties handling your information to maintain similar safeguards.

However, no method of transmission over the Internet is completely secure. We cannot guarantee absolute security and are not liable for unauthorized access resulting from factors beyond our control. Email communications are not secure; please avoid sending sensitive information via email.
