

HYCO LAKE CAMPGROUND RULES & GUIDELINES

Welcome to Hyco Lake Park & Campground. We want our guests to have an enjoyable experience and create great memories while staying with us. We have implemented guidelines for campers to ensure we meet our goals of keeping the campground clean, safe, and enjoyable for all our guests. Thank you for staying with us! ******* Sites and cabins are vacation rentals only and are not intended for permanent residency.**

Arrival / Departure

- Photo ID is required at check-in. Campers must check in with the Ranger or office before proceeding to campsite.
- Check-in time for campsites & cabins is 3:00pm, check-out is 1:00pm.
- Main gate closes at 11:00pm and re-opens at 6:00am.
- **Any late payments will result in a \$30 late fee and may be grounds for immediate departure.**

Safety / Courtesy

- No deadly or concealed weapons (firearms, fireworks, explosives, etc.).
- No glass bottles, alcoholic beverages greater than 6%, and/or controlled substances.
- No abusive, vulgar language and/or loud music at any time.
- **Children under 12 must remain under adult supervision at all times. Any infractions will be grounds for immediate departure.**
- Quiet time is from 10:00pm-7:00am
- **Please abide by newly installed signage regarding swimming. Call 336-599-4343 with any questions.**

Vehicles / Parking

- Maximum of 2 vehicles per site. Extra vehicles must park in the overflow parking beside ranger house. Vehicles and trailers must be contained to your site. All vehicles must display valid parking pass while on premises.
- Please do not park in unrented sites or common areas. Do not block roadway at any time.
- Guest parking is \$10.00 per day.
- Autos & trailers entering the park must be currently tagged & insured. **No ATV's or off-road vehicles allowed- unless properly licensed by DMV.**
- Golf carts are allowed for a convenience purpose with purchase of \$75.00 annual permit from the office and proof of liability insurance.
- Golf Carts must remain on paved or gravel surfaces
- **No unlicensed drivers of golf carts permitted. No one under the age of 16 is permitted to operate golf carts. ANY infractions of this rule is subject to immediate departure from the premises.**
- Washing vehicles and campers onsite is prohibited.
- No vessels/ trailers can be left in grass fields Monday-Friday. Vessels/trailers may park in the grass field **TEMPORARILY** on Saturday & Sunday and can be left Monday-Friday in the new gravel parking lot.

Pets- See Rules and Regulations for Pet Policy and Breed Restrictions

NEW BOAT PARKING LOT (inside campground)

- Only vehicles towing trailers allowed to use new gravel parking area
- Vessels/trailers **MUST** belong to registered camper- no outside guest parking will be allowed
- Not intended for long term storage
- All vessels must have current PCA annual permit

Trash Disposal

- Please do not discard household trash in restroom or park trash receptacles.
- Dumpsters & trash bags are available for proper disposal of your trash.

Campsite

- Two tents OR one RV & one tent with a maximum of 6 people per campsite.
- Campsites should be kept neat & organized, presenting a pleasing appearance.
- Please no outside electrical units (i.e. refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc.) Dorm room size refrigerators are acceptable.
- For safety purposes, pools, hot tubs, slip & slides, etc. are not permitted.
- No burning of trash and/or fires outside of the fire pit or grill.
- No driving of nails or other objects into trees. Hammocks are to be temporary. Clotheslines are prohibited.
- No outside drying of undergarments/ street clothing. Outside drying of beach towels and swim suits are acceptable (on a temporary basis).
- Valuable items including RV awnings should be stored away when away from your site.
- Management is not responsible for damage, injury, or loss to either property or person.
- All gray and black water must be contained in holding tanks and disposed of at the dump station located at the entrance of the campground.
- **All campers/RVs with 2 AC's MUST occupy a 50 amp site- NO EXCEPTIONS- No converters/reducers will be allowed. Sites must be occupied according to the rating of the camper/RV.**

VIOLATIONS OF HYCO LAKES RULES CAN RESULT IN THE REVOCATION OF CAMPING PRIVILEGES AND PCA IS PROTECTED BY THE GENERAL STATUTE 14-110: DEFAUDING INNKEEPER OR CAMPGROUND OWNER. REFUNDS ONLY RETURNED IF CANCELLATION IS MADE 14 DAYS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL DATE.

Any violations of the above rules will be grounds for immediate departure from the campground. All decisions are final and not subject to exceptions.
