



Open Saga League Player Guide

Welcome to the Open Saga League! This guide is for players who want to register a character and jump into our sanctioned tabletop sessions. We designed our system to be fast, clear, and easy to use, so you can spend less time doing paperwork and more time rolling dice.

How It Works

Getting started in the Open Saga League involves a few simple steps. You will create an account, register your character, and then find an open session that matches your game system and character level.

Create an Account

To begin, sign in through the OSL platform. We keep this easy by automatically pulling your name, email, and Discord username directly from your profile. You do not need to fill out long registration forms to get your account running.

Choose a Game System

When you are ready to bring a character into the league, head over to `/osl/nominate`. Here, you will choose the game system you want to play. Currently, you can pick between Dungeons & Dragons 5e and Old-School Essentials (OSE).

Character Registration (D&D 5e Wizard)

If you select D&D 5e, you will use our quick four-step registration wizard to submit your character.

Step 1: Tier Selection

Choose the tier that matches your character's current level. The league uses these tiers to group characters into balanced adventures:

- **Tier 0 (Level 1):** Brand new adventurers
- **Tier 1 (Levels 2–4):** Novice heroes
- **Tier 2 (Levels 5–10):** Seasoned adventurers
- **Tier 3 (Levels 11–16):** Epic heroes
- **Tier 4 (Levels 17–20):** World-shapers

Step 2: Upload Character Sheet

You can upload a PDF of your character sheet from platforms like D&D Beyond or Roll20, or simply paste a direct PDF link. Our AI tool will read the file and extract all your character details automatically.

Step 3: Player Information

Confirm your personal details. We require your player name and email address. You can

also provide your Discord username, which we highly recommend so you can receive important session notifications.

Step 4: Verification

Submit your character for an AI-powered compliance review. This process checks your sheet against league rules and usually takes about 10 to 15 seconds to complete.

After Verification

Once the review finishes, your character will receive one of three statuses, along with specific feedback:

- **Passed:** Your character is fully legal and ready to play immediately.
- **Needs Minor Fixes:** Your character needs a few small adjustments before you can join a table.
- **Failed:** Your character has major rule violations and must be revised and resubmitted.

(Note: Game Masters and Admins can also manually mark characters as Approved or Rejected if needed).

Joining a Session

When your character reaches a verified status (Passed, Needs Minor Fixes, or Approved), you can sign up for games. Visit </osl/sessions> to browse the calendar. You can only register for sessions that match your character's specific tier and game system.

Canceling a Registration

If your plans change, you can cancel your session registration. Simply go to the specific session detail page and remove yourself from the list. You can do this at any point before the session officially begins.

You can manage your entire roster by visiting </osl/my-characters>. This dashboard allows you to view all your registered characters, check their verification statuses, print your character sheets, and manage your upcoming session registrations in one convenient place.
