Getting Started

Start by downloading the correct app and connecting your Lighting by Legacy controller. Use the steps below in order.

1

Download the App

Download Your AI Life Assistant from the App Store or Google Play.

2

Create Your Account

Open the app and create your account using your preferred email address.

3

Connect Wi-Fi

Enable Bluetooth on your phone and connect to a 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network. 5 GHz networks are not recommended for setup.

4

Add the Controller

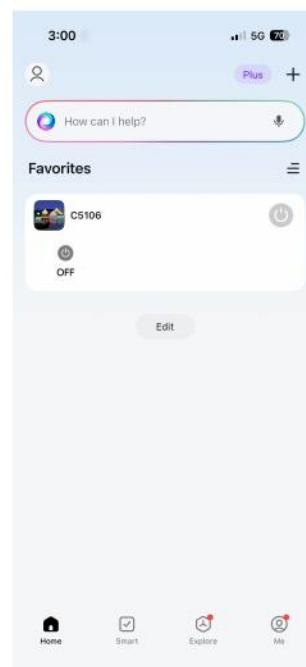
Follow the prompts inside the app to add your Lighting by Legacy controller.

Home Screen

The Home Screen is where you access your controller and the main lighting controls. Tap your controller tile to open the full control screen.

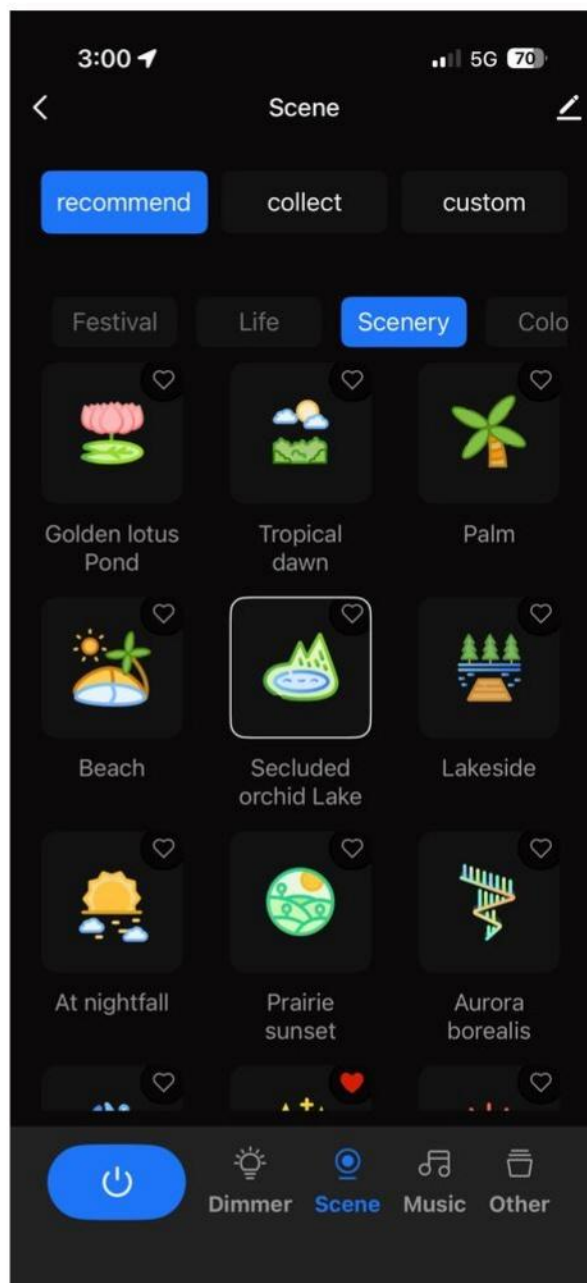
Power Turn the lighting system on or off.

Dimmer Adjust brightness level.

Scene Choose pre-programmed lighting scenes.

Music Sync effects with music or sound.

Other Access additional settings.



Color Selection

Use Color Selection when you want one solid color, a custom color, or a simple everyday accent lighting look.

1

Open Your Controller

From the Home Screen, tap your Lighting by Legacy controller tile.

2

Tap Color or Dimmer

Use the bottom menu and select the color or dimmer control area.

3

Choose a Color

Tap the color wheel or color bar and drag your finger to the color you want.

4

Adjust White Tone

For everyday lighting, choose warm white for a softer architectural look or cool white for a brighter look.

5

Save Favorites

When you find a color you like, save it as a favorite or custom scene for faster access later.

Christmas

Red + Green

Halloween

Orange + Purple

Game Day

Team Colors

Everyday

Brightness Control

Use the Dimmer control to make your lights brighter or softer depending on the occasion.

1

Open the Controller

From the Home Screen, tap your Lighting by Legacy controller tile.

2

Tap Dimmer

On the bottom navigation menu, tap Dimmer.

3

Move the Brightness Slider

Drag the brightness slider left to dim the lights or right to make the lights brighter.

4

Preview the Change

Watch the roofline lights while adjusting until the brightness looks right.

5

Use Recommended Levels

For everyday accent lighting, try 30-50%. For holidays or parties, use 80-100%.

6

Keep or Save

Leave the brightness setting as-is, or save it as part of a favorite scene if the app provides that option.

Music Mode

Music Mode allows the lights to react to sound and create animated effects for parties, holidays, and special events.

1

Open the Controller

From the Home Screen, tap your Lighting by Legacy controller tile.

2

Tap Music

On the bottom navigation menu, tap Music.

3

Allow Microphone Access

If your phone asks for permission, allow microphone access so the app can listen for sound.

4

Choose a Music Effect

Select the music effect or rhythm mode you want to use.

5

Play Music Nearby

Play music near your phone so the app can detect the beat.

6

Adjust Sensitivity

If available, adjust sensitivity, speed, color, and brightness until the effect looks right.

Tip Music Mode usually works best when your phone is close to the sound source and background noise is limited.

Custom Scenes

Custom Scenes let you build and save lighting looks for holidays, sports teams, parties, and everyday architectural lighting.

1

Open the Scene Screen

Tap your controller, then tap Scene on the bottom navigation menu.

2

Select Custom

At the top of the Scene screen, tap Custom.

3

Create a New Scene

Tap the edit, plus, or add button to begin creating a new scene.

4

Choose Colors and Motion

Select colors, brightness, speed, and pattern style such as fade, chase, flash, or wave.

5

Name the Scene

Give the scene a clear name such as Christmas, Game Day, Warm White, or Halloween.

6

Save and Test

Save the scene and test it by turning it on from the app.

*** NOTE & TIP**

Your system remembers the last scene displayed.

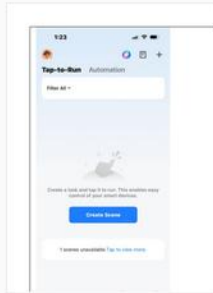
During the evening, you may switch between different scenes. The final scene displayed before powering the system off will automatically be stored in memory. When the system is powered back on, that same scene will be the first scene displayed.

Tip: Leave the system on your favorite scene before turning it off.

Scheduling and Timers

Create a daily schedule so your lights turn on, display your selected scene, and turn off automatically.

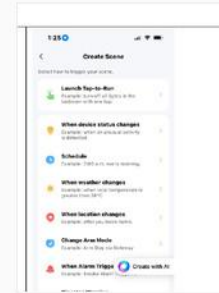

Step 1

First tap the Smart button at the bottom of the page.

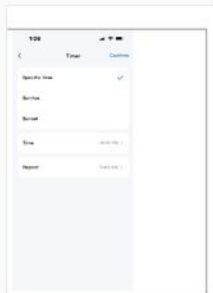

Tap the Schedule button.

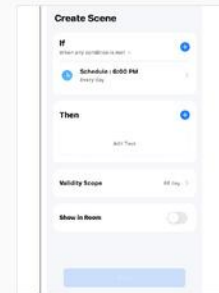

Set Specific time to 6 PM. Set Repeat to Every Day, then tap Confirm.

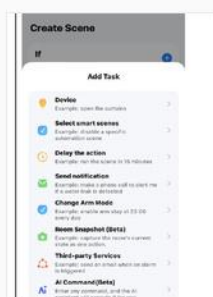

Your 6 PM schedule is now set. Next, tap the Then button.

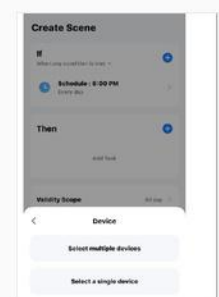

Tap the Device button.

Tap Select a single device.

Scheduling and Timers

Choose your controller, scene, and delay so the schedule runs for the amount of time you prefer.

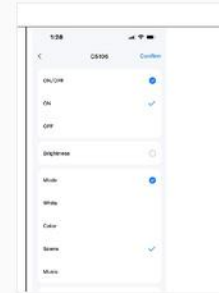

Select your device. If two controllers are shown, select the controller for your system.

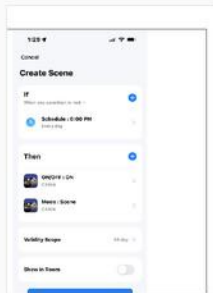

Select On, select Mode, choose Scene, then tap Confirm.

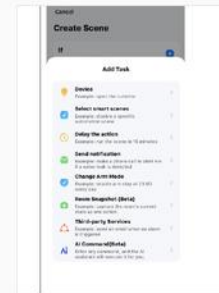

Your 6 PM schedule is now set to turn on and display the selected scene. Tap Then again.

Tap Delay the action.

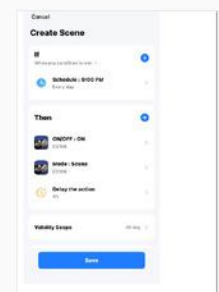

Set the delay for how long you want the scene to stay on, then tap Confirm.

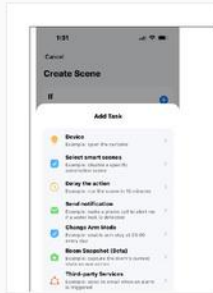
Step 12

The delay action is now set. Tap Then again.

Scheduling and Timers

Finish the schedule by adding the OFF command, saving the routine, and naming it clearly.

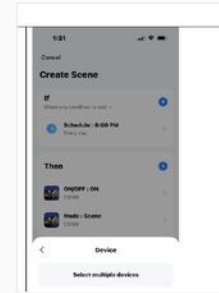

Tap the Device button again.

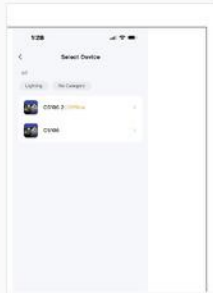

Tap Select a single device.

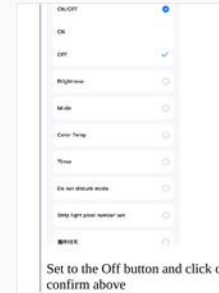

Select your device.

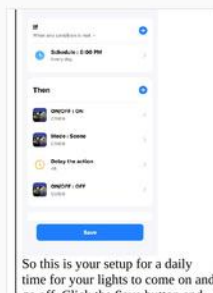

Set the device to Off, then tap Confirm.

The daily on/off schedule is now set. Tap Save and give it a name.

Important Scheduling Tip

Start with the scene you want by opening your lighting system, selecting the scene, and turning the system off. From that point forward, that scene will display every night at the scheduled time and turn off at the scheduled time. If you later select a new scene and turn the system off, the new scene becomes the one used by the schedule.
