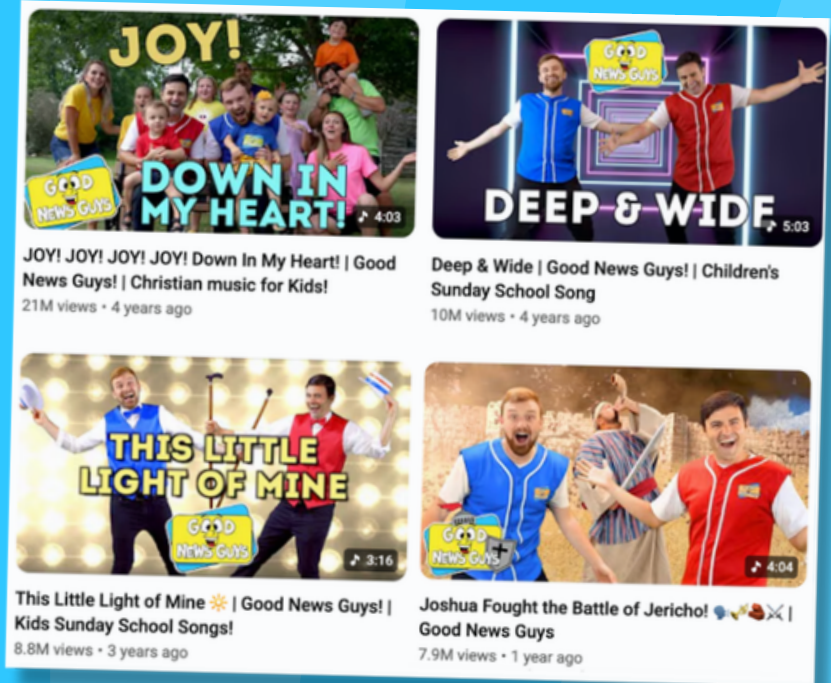

1 HOW WORSHIP BUILDS BIBLICAL FOUNDATIONS & HIDES GOD'S TRUTH IN KIDS' HEARTS

After years of creating Bible-filled songs and hearing families sing them back in living rooms, churches, and live events, Vinnie and Jordan have seen that worship rarely stays confined to one moment. They discuss why children love repetition, how participation helps truth become familiar, and what it means to create songs that parents and kids can carry together beyond the screen or stage.

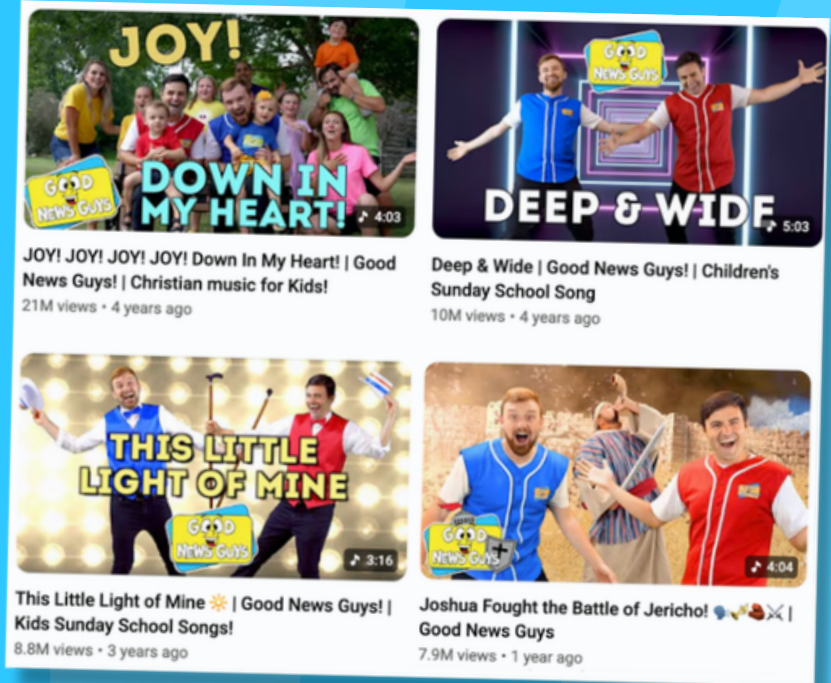
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
