The Pharisees didn't understand

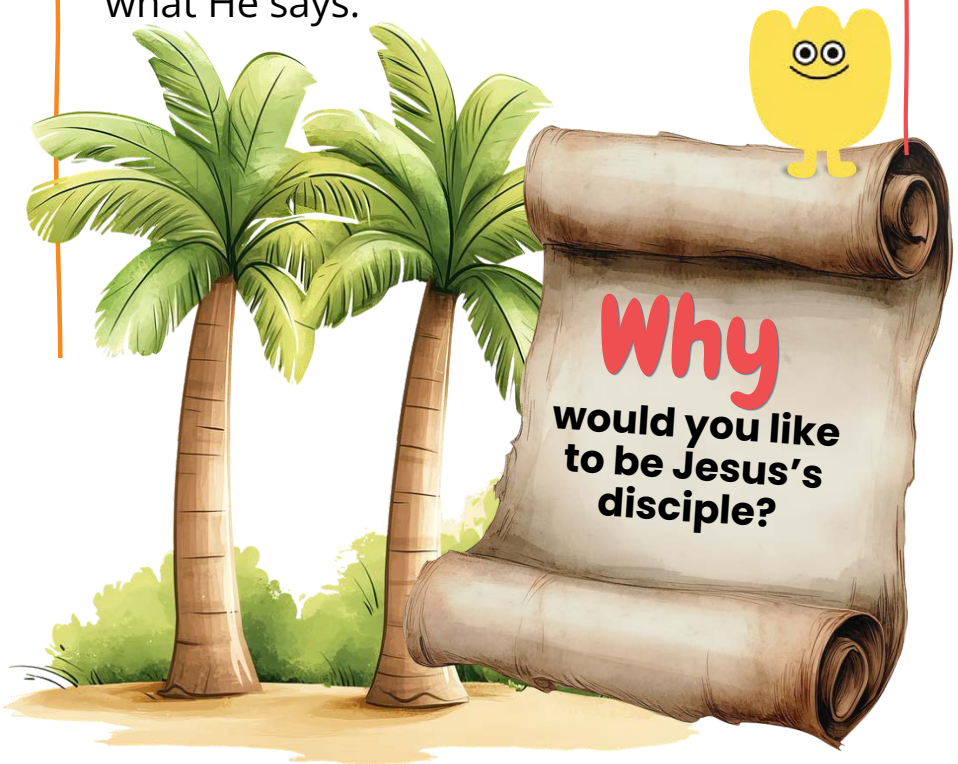

FAITH AT HOME

Thoughts on the Story:

Jesus is the light of the world. He helps us see the way things should be, He helps us understand God's love, and He shows us how we can help live in loving and healthy ways. When we follow Jesus's example, we shine light into the world, too! Our lights help people see Jesus's love for them.

With the Kids:

- Read through this Bible booklet and discuss the lesson. Ask the children to tell you how it feels to be in darkness. Have them describe what they see and feel. Ask them to tell you how they feel in the light.
- Jesus's light shows through love. Ask the children how they can show Jesus's love to other people.

For the Grown-ups:

- Read John 8:2-32. There are many more details in this reading than we covered during Wiggle Church. The Pharisees were people in the church who believed that all of God's laws should be followed exactly as they were written. They were skeptical that Jesus was the Messiah, so they asked Him many questions trying to prove He wasn't God's Son.
- What are some of your doubts or questions about who Jesus is and what He teaches?
- How do Jesus's words and actions assure you that He can be trusted?
